




INTRODUCTION



The Sheikh Zayed Private Academy for Girls (SZPAG) is one of a group of schools established to offer students a blended curriculum which promotes a strong sense of Emirati identity within an international framework. This outstanding global education provides students with increased opportunities as they move beyond the school setting and into the workplace.

The "Arabi "Program for Enhancement of the Arabic Language Skills

Under the patronage of Her Highness Sheikha Fatima bint Hamdan bin Zayed Al Nahyan, The Sheikh Zayed Private Academies launched the Arabi program at the beginning of the academic year 2022-2023. In support of the UAE leadership's efforts to preserve the Arabic language and to reinforce it among students, this program seeks to strengthen the Arabic language from KG 1 to grade 12. This will enhance students' skills and confidence enabling them to use it in their daily lives. The program has been designed in accordance with the best practices and research in the field of Arabic language pedagogy.

1:1 iPads program from Gr3 to Gr12

Students and teachers at SZPAG are changing the way children learn with innovative uses of technology. Our leaders and teachers have embedded technology within the curriculum to redefine learning. The school uses iPads to improve independence, ownership of learning, creativity, literacy and much more. Apple technology helps us enthuse students by creating exciting teaching videos, live demonstrations and interactive workbooks.

THE CURRICULUM

We offer the American Massachusetts State curriculum

The Sheikh Zayed Private Academies selected the Massachusetts State Curriculum Frameworks to deliver our American-curriculum education. This framework provides teachers, students and families with clear and shared expectations for what all students should know and be able to do at the end of each year (standards-based learning). In support of this, students engage with their teachers in challenging lessons that meet their educational needs in all subject areas. The standards represent a promise of equitable education for all students. They formalize the expectation that all students have access to the same academic content, regardless of their location, background or abilities.

We believe our students should be equipped with the competencies and values to be contributors and leaders of society. Our curriculum is distinguished by its focus on rigor, differentiation and innovation. We strive to use active learning models that encourage critical thinking, problem-solving and language development. Our school offers a comprehensive and growing Advanced Placement (AP) Program to provide students with the opportunities to study at the college level at High School. Full support is provided to the students to ensure the highest outcomes in both internal assessments and the external end-of-year AP Examinations.

As part of our drive to educate for the future, the school includes green screen facilities, digital music suites and high IT infrastructure to compliment our one-to-one iPad program.

Arabic Language

The Sheikh Zayed Private Academy for Girls provides education in mandatory subjects such as the Arabic language (for grades 1-12), Islamic Education (for grades 1-12) and UAE Social Studies (for grades 1-9) according to the curriculum set by the UAE Ministry of Education (MoE). In these subjects, students are divided into classes for Arab and non-Arab students in compliance with the MoE curriculum requirements.



SPECIAL EDUCATIONAL NEEDS AND STUDENTS OF DETERMINATION

We will make reasonable adjustments to our admissions procedure for Special Educational Needs (SEN) students.

Our school may not be able to admit students who cannot be appropriately served by school services, resources and programs. The requirement for Learning Support Services will be identified as part of the admissions screening process. If required, enrollment in the Learning Support/Special Educational Needs (LS/SEN) program will form a non-negotiable condition of acceptance to the school. We may request the parent to provide an individual assistant for the student to support their academic needs.

Language Proficiency

Students with limited proficiency in either or both the English and Arabic languages may be admitted only after considering:

- · Space availability
- · Records of past academic achievement
- · Results of the entrance assessment
- · Official diagnostic report
- · Level of student support required



Making education accessible

We can offer a range of specialist support and we welcome children with mobility needs and special education needs. Our campus is equipped for access by wheelchair. Please contact our Admissions office to discuss any necessary adjustments to meet your child's individual needs. If necessary, a meeting will be arranged to discuss provisions throughout the admissions process. While we will try to meet the costs of reasonable adjustments, we reserve the right to charge for additional services

Access arrangements

Students with special needs may be allowed additional time in the entrance examinations at the discretion of the Head of the School. Documentary evidence, such as current educational and psychologist reports, should be submitted to the school along with the application form. For applicants who have existing statements of special educational needs, a meeting may take place between the school and the applicant's parents prior to the entrance examination.



MEETING YOUR CHILD NEEDS

All SEN cases are dealt with on an individual basis and the purpose of these meetings is to establish whether we can reasonably meet the needs of your child. Students for whom Arabic is a second language may receive additional Arabic instruction.

For students with special educational needs, the following documents must be submitted with their application:

- The most recent report from an Educational Psychologist, and/or other outside services attended by the student.
- The most recent Individual Education Plan from their current school.
- The most recent medical report.

Please note that failure to provide us with information related to an SEN diagnosis may result in an offer of a place being withdrawn.

OUR UNIQUE PROGRAMS

The Sheikh Zayed Private Academy for Girls aims to develop a generation of young women who are proud of their identity, culture and heritage. Our students are well-educated and prepared to meet the challenges in an ever-changing world. The Academy provides a range of unique enrichment programs that are specifically designed for students to develop their characters in all aspects; enhance their skills; help them acquire a greater knowledge; and prepare them in their journey to become active citizens.




Helping Hands Program

In pursuit of enhancing the spirit of cooperation and community service, the school adopted the idea of helping needy families through a project named "Helping Hands". This is a joint program between SZPAG and the UAE Red Crescent. This initiative aims to provide help to needy families by refurbishing and furnishing their homes, catering to their needs through the support of the academy's students and their families.



First Aid & CPR Program

This is a mandatory training program for grade 12 students. It is provided by AAEI and approved by Sheikh Khalifa Medical City and the American Heart Association. At the end of the training program, students receive an approved license that entitles them to practice first aid and save the lives of people who need CPR where required.



Student Council

SZPAG runs both elementary and secondary student councils. The council representatives are chosen through student elections. Throughout the year, student council members meet to discuss a variety of topics and coordinate events for the student body.



My Identity Program

The My Identity Program is an exclusive program for all students from KG to grade 12 which seeks to promote UAE national identity and equip students with moral values to ensure their comprehensive self and social growth.

EXTRA CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

SZPAG students actively engage in a well-rounded education through a combination of challenging coursework and diverse extra curricular activities. They develop their leadership skills by participating in workshops, lectures and community service with organizations like the Red Crescent. The students also take an active role in shaping their school's development through the Student Council.

At SZPAG, we believe extracurricular activities are essential for our students. They allow our students to learn about themselves and their interests. They help develop skills that will help them in their future careers and life.

Our ECAs allow our students to make friends, improve their social skills and get involved in new activities that might not otherwise be accessible to them.

Our ECAs also provide a channel for reinforcing lessons learned in the classroom. They offer students opportunities to apply academic skills in real-world contexts and are thus considered part of a well-rounded education.

Gr.1 – Gr.5 ECAs offer a variety of clubs in many subject areas, including science, math, sports, the arts and technology. We also offer partnership programs such as Formula 1 in Schools race car building, internationally recognized Junior Duke Awards and Unified Robotics in partnership with Unified Champion Schools.

In Secondary School, we offer a variety of clubs with different focuses, including art, creativity and support clubs, ensuring that there is something to appeal to everyone. Additionally, we have external examination preparation clubs to guide our students and support them in preparation for acceptance into their universities such as SAT, MAP, EmSAT and AP exams preparations.

EXTRA CURRICULAR

UNIFORM, APPEARANCE AND CATERING

Uniform

SZPAG maintains a strict uniform policy. Students must wear the official school uniform as outlined for each grade level and modifications are not permitted. All students must remain in school uniform throughout the day unless otherwise informed. Students must have a change of clothes and shoes for Physical Education (PE) as per the uniform requirements.

Hair Style Requirements

SZPAG students are expected to stay neat, but hairstyles can be very much up to interpretation regarding how appropriate they may be in a school setting. Therefore, SZPAG would like to clarify the expectations regarding 'conventional hairstyles' and those cuts not appropriate for school. 
Catering

We strive to ensure our students select healthy food choices aligned with Abu Dhabi Agriculture and Food Safety Authority (ADAFSA) each day and expect them to bring healthy snacks and lunch choices if they choose a packed lunch.

Water coolers are installed in every class but we ask all our students to bring a refillable water bottle to school each day for PE and recess times.


An in-school catering service is available for grades 2 to 12. This service is provided by "Fresh Bite Paprika Catering". They offer a "grab and go" service only. This includes hot and cold food in pre-wrapped portions.

- Pre-K to grade 1 students should bring a healthy snack to school each day.
- Grade 2 to grade 3 students can bring a healthy snack to school each day and parents have the option to order food from the school canteen which will be delivered to the homeroom during break time (orders will be online from the student canteen account).
- Grade 4 to 12 students can bring a healthy snack to school each day or they can purchase food from the school canteen.



TRANSPORTATION

- School bus services for The Sheikh Zayed Private Academy for Girls are provided by Emirates Transport.
- This is partly a result of the regulations established by the Department of Transport which stipulate that student bus routes must not exceed a duration of 60 minutes from the starting point to the final destination.
- School bus fees for the academic year remain at AED 5,000. The bus fees will be determined in May June. Seats can only be secured after complete payment.
- The school will notify parents before the start of the academic year when the booking system is open to complete payments.
- For safety and security, all SZPA buses are CCTV monitored and a licensed approved bus supervisor is designated for each school bus.

- · Bus services run Monday through Friday on Abu Dhabi Island only.



THE SCHOOL DAY

The Academic Year

The school calendar must be approved by the Abu Dhabi Department of Education and Knowledge (ADEK) every year. The instructional program is organized into three terms:

• Term 1: August - December

• Term 2: January - March

• Term 3: April - July

The exact dates are determined annually as per the ADEK approved calendar.

Drop-off

Doors to the school open at 7:30 AM and all students must be in their homeroom by 8:00 AM for registration.

The SZPAG uses a staggered entry system in September for Pre-K and KG1 children. Students come to school in smaller groups for shorter periods of time during the first two weeks. All acceptances Pre-K to KG2 are conditional until the ADEK system is closed for school transfer. If it becomes apparent during this time that a student would benefit from a delay in the commencement of formal schooling, we reserve the right to revoke the offer of a place.



HOW TO APPLY

The first step in the application process is to complete the online registration form:

The Admissions Department will contact you within 24 hours of receipt of your inquiry.

- 1. Submit your online inquiry through the school website and the Admissions Department will get back to you within one working day.
- 2. Submit your completed online application with all required documents (below) in order to proceed with the registration process.
- 3. The Admissions Department will contact you to schedule your child's assessment.
- 4. Within one week of a successful assessment, an offer letter will be sent if seats are available (check How Children Get Offers).
- 5. When the offer is accepted and the registration fee is paid, the Admissions Department will send your child's file to ADEK for review. Once he/she is fully registered, your child will be enrolled.

The requested registration documents are:

- · Health Record Form*
- · Recommendation Form* (This must be completed and stamped by the student's current or most recent school)
- Copy of student's passport
- · Copy of student's Emirates ID
- · Copy of parent or legal guardian's passport and residence visa (for non-National applicants)
- Copy of family entry (for Nationals)
- Copy of student's birth certificate (attested for non-Nationals)
- 3 passport-size photos
- · Copy of immunization card
- Copy of water and electricity bill showing the premises ID for ADEK registration
- · Copies of report cards for the last two years

*These will be sent to you by the Admissions Department Places cannot be offered if applications are incomplete.



REGISTRATION OPENS IN NOVEMBER

REGISTRATION GUIDELINES

Please mark your calendar. The SZPAG opens the next school year registration at the beginning of November every year.

Inquiry and Assessments

- Parents are encouraged to visit and tour the school.
- Parents can phone or email the school Admissions Department.
- · Parents should access the SZPAG website and submit the online inquiry https://www.szpag.com/szpag
- The Admissions Department will send the link for the application.
- Parents will complete the application link and submit all required documents.
- The Admissions Department will contact the parent to schedule the child's assessments and interview.

Acceptance and Enrollment

- Successful students will be offered a seat pending availability.
- Parent signs offer letter.
- Parent submits all ADEK required documents.
- Parent pays a 5% Registration fee.
- Child is fully registered on ADEK system.


Pre-K to Grade 1

Who Can apply?

- Pre-K (For 3-year-olds): Your child will enter Pre-K in September of the next calendar year. Children must be 3 years old by August 31 of the academic year to attend Pre-K.
- KG1 (For 4-year-olds): Your child will enter KG1 in September of the next calendar year. Children must be 4 years old by August 31 of the academic year to attend KG1.
- KG2 (5-year-olds): Your child will enter KG2 in September of the next calendar year. Children must be 5 years old by August 31 of the academic year to attend KG2.
- Grade 1 (For 6-year-olds): Your child will enter grade 1 in September of the next calendar year. Children must be 6 years old by August 31 of the academic year to attend grade 1.

Pre-K to Grade 1

How Children Get Offers?

Pre-K, KG1, and KG2

At the beginning of January, Pre-K, KG1, and KG2 children will be invited to group or one-to-one interviews/meetings to determine school readiness.

Grade 1

Students will attend an interview to assess basic literacy (English and Arabic) and numeracy skills.

What is Next?

Student acceptance is based on seat availability. Children who are accepted will receive offer letters within a week of the meeting provided that complete applications with all supporting documentation have been submitted. Families will be notified by phone and email

To secure your child's seat at the SZPAG, please sign and return the offer with all the required documents within one week of the offer date. In accordance with ADEK Policy 39, a registration fee of 5% of the annual school fee is payable upon the student's acceptance to the SZPAG.

Grade 2 to Grade 5

How Children Get Offers?

Online Registration opens in November for the applications for the next calendar year.

- Students' parents must submit the Continuation of Study or the Sequence Letter.
- The end-of-year report card for the previous year must be submitted along with the other required documents.
- The Admissions Committee approval.

Who Can apply?

- Age-appropriate for the requested grade level as per SZPA placement policy.
- Successful completion of the previous school year.
- · Submission of ADEK Sequence Letter.
- Students transferring within the Abu Dhabi Region must complete the process before the ADEK system is closed for school transfer (ADEK might give exceptions for the students to be transferred from Al Ain Region, Al Dhafra Region and the other Emirates within UAE).

Grade 2 to Grade 5

Grade 2 Assessments:

• Students will be assessed in English reading and writing, mathematics and Arabic, using grade-level leaders.

Grades 3-5 Assessments:

- Individual interviews will be arranged.
- Students will complete an Admissions questionnaire.
- Students are required to take English reading, writing, and numeracy assessments using the Measure of Academic Progress (MAP), which are online standardized tests.
- · Arabic reading and writing assessments will be conducted.

Student files will be reviewed by the Admissions Committee for final decision. Children who are accepted will receive offer letters within a week of the date of the assessment provided that complete applications, with all supporting documentation, have been submitted. Families will be notified by phone and email.

What is Next?

To secure your child's seat at the SZPAG, please sign and return the offer with all the required documents within one week of the offer date. In accordance with ADEK Policy 39, a registration fee of 5% of the annual school fee is payable upon the student's acceptance to the SZPAG.

How Children Get Offers?

Online Registration opens in November for the applications for the next calendar year.

Who Can apply?

- Age-appropriate for the requested grade level as per SZPA placement policy.
- · Successful completion of the previous school year.
- · Submission of ADEK Sequence Letter.
- · Previous school records (report cards, transfer certificate, recommendation and behavioral feedback letters).
- Students transferring within Abu Dhabi Region must complete the process before the ADEK system is closed for school transfer
 (ADEK might give exceptions for the students to be transferred from Al Ain Region, Al Dhafra Region and the other Emirates
 within UAE).

Additional requirements for Grades 10-12

- · Last 2 years' internal and eSIS report cards showing promotion to the next grade level
- · Letter of Equivalency
- · ADEK approval
- Parent undertaking

Seat Availability

Each grade has a certain number of available seats. If a grade has more applicants than seats, admissions priorities are used to make offers.

Assessments and Interviews

- Child must be age-appropriate for the requested grade level (Continuation of study).
- Students are required to take an English reading, writing, and numeracy assessment using Measure of Academic Progress (MAP), which is an online standardized test.
- Arabic Reading and Writing assessments will be conducted.
- Individual interviews will be arranged for grade 6 through grade 12 students.
- Students must complete an Admissions questionnaire.

What is Next?

To secure your child's seat at the SZPAG, please sign and return the offer with all the required documents within one week of the offer date. In accordance with ADEK Policy 39, a registration fee of 5% of the annual school fee is payable upon the student's acceptance to the SZPAG.
